





Installing the track


- Screw-fit mounting brackets/ceiling mounts to the track. When wall-mounting, any unevenness of the wall of up to ±3 mm can be compensated by moving the bracket within the slot. No mounting brackets/ceiling mounts are required for direct mounting.
- Mount the rail at every second hole.
- If the clip-on trim panel is used, fit clips
 and spacers as described in section "Fitting the clip-on trim panel".
- Install the track to wall or ceiling, making sure that the running rail is mounted horizontally.
- Observe distances in attachment B.
- For wall mounting, fit running rail and fixing bracket with spacers of at least 8 mm thickness.


Preassembling the door leaf

- Using screws, fit support plates to the upper end face of the door at intervals of 60 mm from the edge and centred on the leaf thickness.
- Two support plates per door leaf. The open end of the slot must face the wall.
- ► Fit coupling bracket half-way between the support plates.
- Door leaf edge with slots faces wall for one leaf and in opposite direction for other. Slotted face should be about 13 mm from leaf axis.










Assembling the running rail

Starting from the left, slide components into the track in the following order: 1× in rail buffer, 2× roller carriage, 2× in rail buffer, 2× roller carriage, 1× in rail buffer.


Position the latching spring on the end at which latching is required.

Observe direction of buffers.

Slide in rail buffer to the desired end stop position and tighten to 5 Nm.



- Slide deflection pulley into the track.
- Do not secure the deflection pulley.
- At the opposite rail end, slide second deflection pulley into running rail and secure.



Fitting the door leaves


- Engage door leaves in mounting bolt. Firmly tighten lock nut.
- For wall mounting: Fit the door leaf whose coupling bracket faces the wall first as its belt clamp screw is difficult to access.
- Adjust leaf height by turning the suspension bolt clockwise or anticlockwise before tightening the lock nut.


Fitting the toothed belt

- Lay toothed belt around one deflection pulley with the smooth side facing inwards.
- Place toothed belt around deflection pulley and connect its ends at the coupling bracket nearest the wall.
- ► Cut the toothed belt to the required length and secure in the belt clamp a, making sure that the belt is as tightly tensioned as possible.
- Repeat procedure for second coupling bracket, observing position of door leaf.

Tensioning the toothed belt


- Pull the loosened deflection pulley towards the outside and tighten to 5 Nm.
- If the toothed belt is too long, open belt
 clamp, shorten toothed belt, retighten belt clamp.
- The toothed belt must not sag.






Final assembly of door leaves

- Screw-fit an additional door buffer half way up the door leaf.
- Clip on the end cap (optional).
